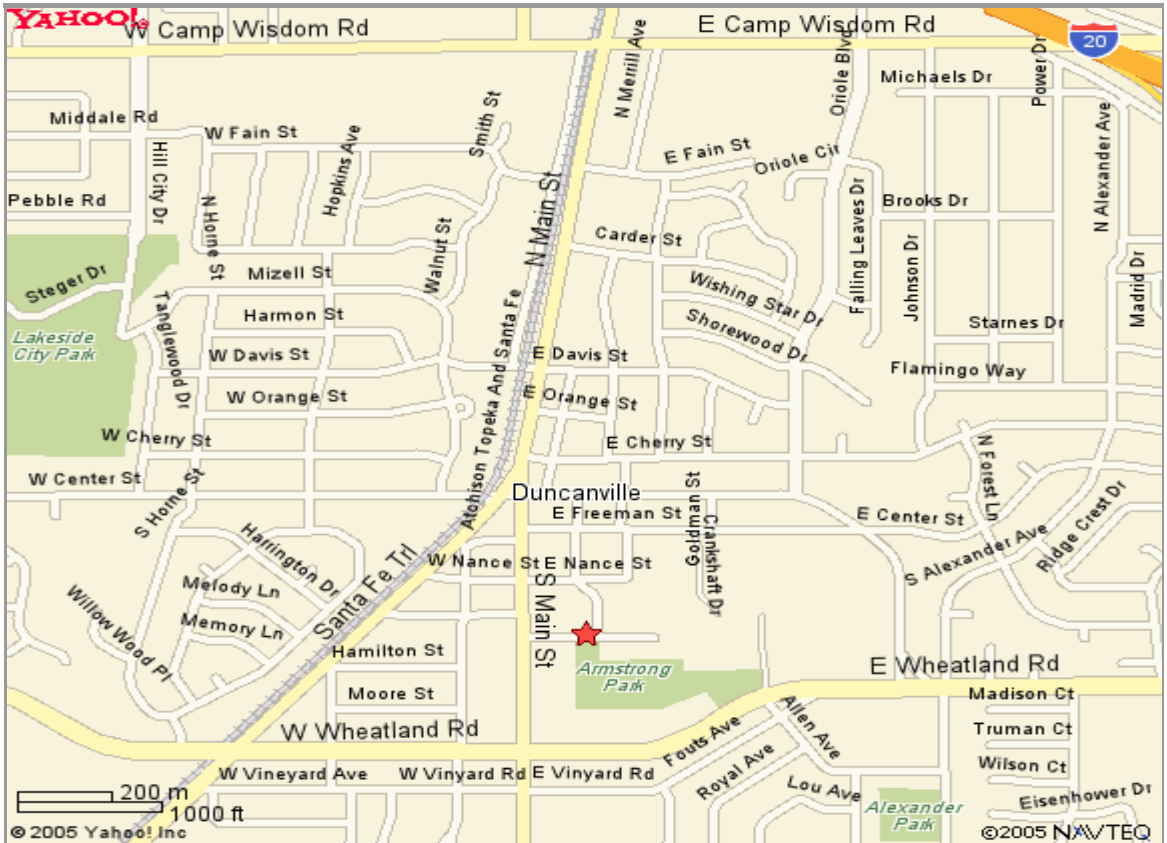

If you are coming from the South:
 Take Hwy 67 North and exit Main St.
 Turn left on Main St. and drive past Daniieldale and Wheatland.
 Turn right on James Collins Blvd. (across from Chase Bank)

Building Location:
 The Methodist Church is on the right where you turn left onto James Collins,
 Armstrong Park and Kidsville is also right there.
